HOME ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAM

INFORMATION ON FREE ENERGY AUDIT

The Town of Fairfield is pleased to announce a new initiative that was made possible by funding received under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. You must be a Fairfield resident, a customer of The United Illuminating Company and 18 years of age or older to apply. Free audits for up to 1500 households are allocated on a first come first served basis. This is an incentive program which will include a free energy assessment, installation of ENERGY STAR CFLs (up to 14), and other free services worth up to \$750. One individual per household may apply. The Town of Fairfield is not responsible for faulty equipment purchased.

Please call 1-877-WISE-USE (877-947-3873) to sign up for this home program. Residential customers who call this number should then ask to sign up for the Home Energy Solutions (HES) program in Fairfield.

Home energy audit

The service may include:

- * A home energy assessment including a blower-door test which pinpoints critical drafts and air leaks. After they are found, the technician will professionally seal them during the visit.
- * A duct test to assess air leaks within the ductwork system. The technician will seal those significant leaks.
- * Hot water-saving measures including low-flow showerheads and faucet aerators will be installed.
- * Rebates up to \$500 for qualifying central air conditioning systems and up to \$300 for replacement of certain inefficient appliances with qualifying energy-efficient models.
- * Installation of energy-efficient compact fluorescent light bulbs.
- * Incentives for insulation upgrades (gas, oil, propane and electric heated homes)
- * A "kitchen table wrap-up" where the technician will review the work that was done in your home and tell you about additional resources that can help you save energy and money.
